Having everything in one place always provides peace of mind for you---and your family. Spring is the perfect time to update and prepare. Here, we highlight a few documents that will help your loved ones have the details they need to be at peace and celebrate your life with love.

- 1. Last Will and Testament and designate an executor of your estate.
- 2. List of Important documents and instructions.
  - Marriage License; Military Documents
  - Vehicle, Property titles or loan information
  - Investments (life insurance, IRA, etc.)
  - Bank accounts with named beneficiaries
- 3. Power of Attorney (ends upon death)
- 4. Health Care Directive and a HIPAA release so your family can receive your health information.
- 5. Statement of Desires. This letter from you would list items and passwords for things like social media, cloud storage, cell phone photos and more. These items are your property, and creating this list will be valuable.
